Tournament Format:

Each bracket is set up so that there are 2 preliminary games and then every team enters a single elimination process (i.e. lose once and team is out of tournament, similar to NCAA tournament) with at least a semi-final round and a championship game. Pig-Tail games will be played to determine who moves on to the quarter final round. Pre-tournament seeding has been established based on everything the tournament director knows about the teams, players, coaches, organizations, previous history etc. Bracket assignments for the single elimination portion will be determined on pre-tournament seeding, results of preliminary games, strength of schedule and personal observations. **Although this will not be a perfect process, every effort will be made to make it fair.** For example, one team might go 1-1 in the preliminary games and still have to play in the Pig-Tail round based on strength of schedule while another team that goes 1-1 might get a bye into the quarter finals. Also, a team might have to beat a team twice (once in the preliminary round and once in the single elimination round) to move on in the tournament. Preliminary games were determined in an attempt to get competitive games while trying to guard against teams playing each other twice. The single elimination match-ups will be determined by tournament director.
